### The Benefits

The program provides many benefits for both the local governments as well as the state:

- Establishes the first public road asset management program in Georgia
- Enhances the accuracy of funding allocation to local governments
- Improves data analytics, road characteristics, and roadway safety
- Strengthens the partnership and facilitates communication between the state and local governments
- Improves required federal reporting

- Roundabout: Inscribed Diameter
